## **WALTON, Isaac, Jr**

London 1651–1719

The son of the celebrated author became domestic chaplain to Seth Ward, bishop of Salisbury; he is credited with an original (and therefore not the Ashfield) crayon portrait of his father said to have been made from recollection after his death. The artist died in London, unmarried.
