? – Florence 1780

Austrian portraitist known for his 1773 group portrait of the imperial family of which some figures are copied in pastel. In 1776 he was appointed royal Sardinian court painter in Turin. It is possible that the three copies in Klagenfurt were made by their owner, Erzherzogin Maria Anna (*q.v.*).
