⇒ Elizabeth (1773–1812) {*Russell*} 2° ∞ 1799 Edward Palmer (1770–1831), druggist, of Throgmorton Street, Clapham and Loughrea, near Galway {*Russell*} [∞ 1° 1796 Marianna Hays (1772–1797), witness Rev Dunkin]; uncle of artist Samuel Palmer, brother of Nathaniel Palmer (1778–1840), cornfactor of Aldermanbury, partner of Robert Garnett; ∞ 1803 Joanna Dunkin, dau. of John Dunkin [son of Thomas & Elizabeth Palmer, born Kettering]

⇒ Edward Palmer (1804–1872), druggist of Tooley Street, Southwark ∞ Jemima Closs Law (1804–1884)

⇒ Jemima Palmer (1830–) of Barnsbury ∞ Islington 1855 John Jones (Ireland 1820–), secretary of colliery, of Mount Preston, Leeds, 1894

⇒ John Alfred Jones (1863–) ∞ 1892 Edith Maria Town
