Hamilton; Lawrence; Westall*}, ∞ 1<sup>o</sup> 1784 James Esten (1757–1803), lieutenant, RN, of Half-Moon Street; 3<sup>o</sup> ∞ 2<sup>o</sup> 1812 Major John Scott-Waring (1747–1819), agent of Warren Hastings [∞ 1<sup>o</sup> 1772 Elizabeth Blackrie (1745–1796); 2<sup>o</sup> 1796 Maria Hughes {*Russell*}]

⇒⇒ Harriet Wildman Hunter Esten (1788–1881) ∞ Thomas Darby-Coventry

⇒ Anna Maria (–1803sp) {*Lawrence*} 1<sup>o</sup> ∞ St Anne’s Soho 1792 John Smith Braine, chief-clerk of the Navy Pay-office, of Craven-hill cottage

⇒ Caroline Sophia Pye (–1857) {*Lawrence*} ∞ 1809 Captain Donald Macleod, RN, CB (–a.1852)

⇒⇒ Katherine Augusta Westernra Macleod (1823–1902) ∞ 1852 Octavius Douglas-Hamilton, cousin of the 9<sup>th</sup> Duke of Hamilton
