⇒ William, 17th Earl of Erroll (1772–1819) ∞ 1^o 1792 Jane Bell (c.1770–1793); 2^o 1796 Alicia (1778–1812) {*Gardner*}, youngest dau. of Samuel Eliot of Antigua; 3^o 1816 Lady Harriet Somerville (1786–1864)

⇒ Mary (1754–) ∞ 1770 General John Scott of Balcomie

⇒ Charlotte (1763–1800) of Etal ∞ 1797 Rev. William Holwell Carr (1758–1830), vicar of Menheniot {*Vale*}

⇒ Augusta (–1822) ∞ 1788 George, Earl of Glasgow

⇒ Maria Elizabeth (–1804) ∞ 1795 Rev. George Moore {*Gardner*}, son of the archbishop of Canterbury
