Colonel Robert Carpenter (–1745), 3rd Guards, killed at Fontenoy, of Portslade ∞ Hester N (1697–1742)
⇒ General Benjamin Carpenter (1713–1788), colonel 12th, then 4th dragoons, equerry to the King 1761, principal equerry 1783, clerk-marshal of the mews 1771; drowned himself in Serpentine {*Lion*} ∞ 1753 Mary Carr, dau. of Lieutenant-Colonel Timothy Carr
⇒ Lucy (1760–1842) {*Lion*} ∞ George Ramsden (1761–1793), captain in the 15th Light Dragoons
⇒ Frances (1761–1827) {*Lion; Romney*} ∞ 1783 Henry Gough, Lord Calthorpe (1749–1798)
⇒ Arabella ∞ William Ray (1707–1779), canon of Wells Cathedral
⇒ William Carpenter Ray (1768–1845), vicar of Boreham 1795, of Pakenham 1805
