Richard Chambers, haberdasher and lace-maker of Worksop 2^o ∞ 1739 Rebecca Beresford [∞ 1^o N Turner, relation of the Page family]

⇒⇒ Alicia Dearsly Chambers (1780–1859sp) {*Russell*} ∞ 1807 Gabriel Keteriche Nicholls (c.1785–?a.1828), goldsmith, son of Benjamin Nicholls, ironmonger of Tower Street, brother of Letitia Ann Nicholls ∞ William Russell, son of the artist

Thomas Chamber or Chambers (1677–1736), of Hanworth, Middlesex ∞ Lady Mary Berkeley (1678–?1783)
