Charles Cornwallis, 3rd Baron Cornwallis (1655–1698), First Lord of the Admiralty {*Levy*} ∞ 1^o 1673 Elizabeth Fox (c.1655–1681) {*Levy*}, dau. of Sir Stephen Fox *q.v.*; 2^o Anne Scott, Duchess of Buccleuch

⇒⇒⇒ Charles Cornwallis, cr. 1st Marquess Cornwallis 1792 (1738–1805), KG 1801, general 1793; surrendered at Yorktown 1781; governor-general of India 1786–93, 1805 {*Bacon; Gardner; Hamilton; Reynolds; Smart*} ∞ 1768 Jemima Tulikens Jones (–1779) {*Reynolds*}

⇒⇒⇒⇒ Lady Mary Cornwallis (1769–) {*Gardner*} ∞ 1785 Mark Singleton (1762–1840), barrister, MP for Eye

⇒⇒⇒⇒ Charles, Viscount Brome, 2nd Marquess Cornwallis (1774–1823), Master of the King's Hounds {*Gardner*} ∞ 1797 Lady Louisa Gordon (–1850) {*Gardner*}

⇒⇒⇒⇒ Sir William Cornwallis (1744–1819), Admiral of the Fleet {*Gardner*}

⇒⇒⇒⇒ Lady Mary (1736–1770) ∞ Samuel Whitbread (1720–1796) brewer and philanthropist *q.v.*

⇒⇒⇒⇒⇒ Mary Whitbread (1770–1858) {*Gardner; Beechey*} ∞ 1795 Sir George Grey, Bt (1767–1828), captain, RN *q.v.*
