⇒⇒⇒ Anne de Crespigny (1739–1797) {*Read*} ∞ 1^o 1765 Bonouvrier Glover (1739–1780), captain, RN, of Camberwell, brother of Richard Glover (1750–1822), MP; 2^o 1783 James Vernon, né Gladell (1746–1819), nephew of 1st Earl of Shipbrook

⇒⇒⇒ Jane (1742–1829) ∞ Henry Reveley (1737–1798) {*Hamilton*}

⇒⇒⇒ Henrietta Reveley (1775–p.1797)

⇒⇒⇒ Claude Champion de Crespigny (1706–1782) {*Hoare*}
