Mary Eyre (1726–1785) {*Gardner*} ∞ Anthony Cooke {*Gardner*}

Francis Eyre of Warkworth (–1804) ∞ 1755 Lady Mary Radcliffe (1732–1798) {*Cotes*}, dau. of Charles Radcliffe, “Earl of Derwentwater”

Mary Letitia Eyre (1784–1860) {*Russell*} ∞ 1° Charles Herbert Pierrepoint; 2° Charles Herbert Pierrepoint, 2<sup>nd</sup> Earl Manvers (1778–1860) {*Russell*}

Samuel Eyre (1663–1734), MP, of Eyreville, Galway ∞ 2° 1696 Anne Stratford

⇒ Stratford Eyre (1697–1765), governor of Galway, vice-admiral of Munster ∞ 1735 Mary Dartiquernave

⇒ Thomas Eyre (?1708–1772), of the 49<sup>th</sup> Foot, surveyor-general, Master of Ordnance in Ireland, colonel of Corps of Engineers in Ireland {*N Hone*} ∞ ?1725 Anne Cooke {*N Hone*} *q.v.*
