⇒⇒⇒ Charles Frederick (1748–1791), colonel, of the East India Company ∞ 1773 Martha Rigden (1751–1794) {*Romney*}
⇒⇒⇒ Mary {*Hoare*} ∞ 1733 Alexander Hume (c.1693–1765spn), MP for Southwark, director of the East India Company 1737–48, acquired estate of Wormley Bury 1739 {*Hoare*} q.v.
