⇒⇒⇒ Phillips Glover (a.1750–1796), of Wispington, Lincoln and Upper Fitzroy Street, London, lieutenant-colonel of the Royal North Lincoln militia, court-martialed 1762, author {[Russell](#)} ∞ 1^o 1751 Mary, dau. of Charles Gore of Horkstow; 2^o 1795 Rebecca Jepson (1751–1831) {[Russell](#)}, dau. of William Jepson, schoolmaster in Lincoln [∞ 1773 William Shoulters (–a.1795)]
