### GREGORY

George Gregory (1670–1746), of Nottingham and Lenton, high sheriff of Nottinghamshire 1694, MP 1701–46 *{Cotes; ?Pond}* ∞ 1693 Susanna Williams (–1781), dau. of William Williams of Rempstone

⇒ William Gregory (–1727sa), of Middle Temple

⇒ George Gregory (–1758) of Harlaxton, high sheriff of Lincolnshire 1740 ∞ 1738 Anne Orton (–1785), dau. of a Whitechapel plumber, great-granddau. of Sir Daniel de Ligne and successful claimant to the Harlaxton estates

⇒ George de Ligne Gregory (1739–1822sa), of Harlaxton and Lenton, high sheriff of Nottinghamshire 1791 *{Russell}*

⇒ ⇒ illegitimate son, George Brooke, undergraduate at Peterhouse, Cambridge 1795–98

⇒ ⇒ William Williams, né Gregory (1742–?1831), of Rempstone, heir to his grandmother's estates, midshipman in Navy 1757–60, lieutenant, Royal Foresters 1762, captain ∞ Olivia Preston

⇒ ⇒ Gregory Gregory, né Williams (1786–1854sa), of Harlaxton

⇒ ⇒ Rev. Edward Gregory (1745–1824sa), fellow of Trinity Hall, Cambridge, rector of Langar, Nottinghamshire

⇒ ⇒ Daniel Gregory (1747–1819), muslin merchant in Amsterdam and as Forbes & Gregory, bankrupt 1793 *{Russell}* ∞ Catherine Buckingham

⇒ ⇒ George Gregory (1776–1860sp), of Harlaxton *{?Russell}* ∞ Elizabeth Pine

⇒ ⇒ Edward Gregory (–1849sp) *{?Russell}* ∞ Mary Pattison, presumably sister or relative of Helen Pattison, Mrs Benjamin Cheese

⇒ Edward Gregory (–p.1808)

⇒ Susanna (–1781sa)

⇒ Theophilus Gregory (–a.1808)

⇒ George Gregory (–p.1808), of the office of Ordnance of the Tower of London
