James Harris (1709–1780), of the Close of Sarum and Great Durnford, FRS, MP ∞ 1745 Elizabeth Clarke

⇒ James Harris, 1st Earl of Malmesbury (1746–1820), KB 1779, GCB 1815, diplomat in Madrid 1768–72, Berlin 1772–76, ambassador to St Petersburg 1776–83, The Hague 1788, Paris 1796, 1797 {*Reynolds; Romney*} ∞ 1777 Harriet Maria Amyand (1761–1830) {*Reynolds; Romney*}, sister of Lady Minto

⇒⇒ James Edward Harris, 2nd Earl of Malmesbury (1778–1841) {*Perronneau*} ∞ 1806 Harriet Susan Dashwood (1783–1815)

⇒⇒ Catherine Gertrude (c.1780–1855sp) {*Perronneau*}, goddau. of Catherine II ∞ 1821 General Sir John Bell (–1876), GCB

⇒⇒ Frances (1784–1847) {*Reynolds*} ∞ 1915 Sir Galbraith Lowry Cole

⇒ Katherine Gertrude (1750–1834) {*Romney*} ∞ 1785 Frederick Robinson (1746–1792) {*Romney*} *q.v.*

⇒ Louisa Margaret Harris (1753–1836sa), singer {*Romney*}
