⇒⇒⇒ Edward William Hawke-Harvey, 4<sup>th</sup> Baron Hawke (1799–1869) ∞ 2<sup>o</sup> 1848 Frances Featherstone

⇒⇒⇒ Frances Cassandra Hawke-Harvey (1851–1921) ∞ 1870 Laurence Parsons, 4<sup>th</sup> Earl of Rosse (1840–1908)
