⇒ Amelia Anne (1772–1829) ∞ 1794 Robert Stewart, Marquess of Londonderry (1769–1822sp) *q.v.*

⇒ George Hobart, 3rd Earl of Buckinghamshire (1731–1804), secretary to embassy at St Petersburg 1762, colonel in army 1799 ∞ 1757 Albinia

Bertie (1739–1816) {*Gardner*} *q.v.*; [∞ *Marie-Anne-Joseph de Libessart, dite Grandi* (1750–), danseuse à l'Opéra de Paris ⇒ ⇒ *past.*]
