⇒⇒⇒⇒ Sir Thomas, 6<sup>th</sup> Bt, 2<sup>nd</sup> Baron Lyttelton (1744–1779sp) (*Brompton; Cosway*) ∞ 1772 Apphia Peach, née Witts (1743–1840)

⇒⇒⇒⇒ Sir Richard Lyttelton (1718–1770), KB 1753 (*Batoni*) ∞ 1745 Rachel, dau. of 2<sup>nd</sup> Duke of Bedford, widow of Duke of Egerton

⇒⇒⇒⇒ William Henry Lyttelton, 7<sup>th</sup> Bt, 1<sup>st</sup> Baron Lyttelton 1794 (1724–1808) (*Reynolds; Romney*) ∞ 1<sup>o</sup> 1761 Mary Macartney; 2<sup>o</sup> 1774 Caroline Bristow
