Robert Medley (1650–1708), lawyer ∞ Dorothy Grimston (–1691)

⇒ Henry Medley (1687–1747sps), RN, vice-admiral of the Red, governor of Newfoundland 1739 {*Cheers; J Ellys*} ∞ Anne Gooch or Goche (1692–1733) [no surviving children according to York Minster monument]

Richard Medley, ferryman of Battersea ∞ ?1694 Alice George

⇒ Henry Medley (1710–1782), of Battersea, clerk and sexton to Chelsea Hospital ∞ 1736 Grace Ludlow (1717–1769)

⇒ George Medley (1740–1805), of Grosvenor Place, Gentleman of the Chapel Royal {*Russell*}; ∞ 1^o Barkham 29.XI.1764 Ann Rebecca Paul (1746–1777/89) {*Russell*}, dau. of George Paul, granddau. of Dr George Paul & Susannah Malyn; 2^o 1798 Henrietta Lockhart (1775–1844)

⇒ Rt Rev. John Medley (1804–1892), DD, bishop of Fredericton ∞ 1826 Christiana Bacon (1806–1841)

⇒ 5th and youngest son: Rev. Edward Shuttleworth Medley (1838–1910), vicar of Hopton-by-Lowestoft

⇒ Richard Medley (1742–1823) of Cannon's Row, Lambeth, coal merchant, and of Clapham and Brightelmstone

⇒ George Medley ∞ Mary N

⇒ Rev. George Rowland Medley (1804–1872), rector of St Nicholas, Colchester, 1872

⇒ Richard Medley (1778–1846), clerk in the Home Office

Samuel Medley (1667–1740/61), butler to Lord Kinnoull, ambassador to the Porte

⇒ Guy Medley (1692–1760), tutor to the Duke of Montague ∞ 1^o 1715 Elizabeth Palmer; 2^o 1735 Elizabeth Tonge

⇒ William Tonge Medley (1736–1760)

⇒ Rev. Samuel Medley (1738–1799), celebrated Baptist minister {*S Medley*} ∞ 1762 Mary Gill

⇒ Samuel Medley (1769–1857), painter ∞ 1^o 1792 Susannah Bowley; 2^o 1818 Elizabeth Smallshaw

⇒ Thomas Medley (1678–1732) of Buxted Place ∞ c.1710 Annabella, dau. of Sir Samuel Dashwood, MP, lord mayor of London 1701
