⇒ William Montagu, 2<sup>nd</sup> Duke of Manchester (1700–1739), KB 1725 ∞ 1723 Lady Isabella Montagu (–1786), dau. of 2<sup>nd</sup> Duke of Montagu, pastellist *q.v.* [*∞* 2<sup>o</sup> 1743 Edward Hussey-Montagu, né Hussey, Earl of Beaulieu (1730–1802sps)]

⇒ Robert Montagu, 3<sup>rd</sup> Duke of Manchester (c.1710–1762) ∞ 1735 Harriet Dunch (–1755) {*Pond*}

⇒ John Montagu, 5<sup>th</sup> Earl of Sandwich (1743–1814) ∞ 1<sup>o</sup> 1766 Lady Elizabeth Montagu (–1768) *q.v.*; 2<sup>o</sup> 1772 Lady Mary Henrietta Paulet (1753–1779)
