⇒ Anne Elizabeth Rhodes (1788–1833) {*J.R. Smith*} ∞ James Armitage (1793–1872), Yorkshire industrialist

⇒ Thomas Rhodes Armitage, philanthropist

⇒ Fairfax Rhodes (1766–1822) ∞ Hannah Firth
⇒ John Rhodes (1814–1898), JP, of Potterneton House, Leeds, stockbroker and investor in coal mining ∞ Mary, dau. of Robert Benson, woolstapler from Leeds
⇒ Fairfax Rhodes (1845–1928spms) of Brockhampton Park, only son, barrister, lieut.-col. Sussex Militia; left his books to Cambridge Union Society ∞ 1° 1871 Mary Cooper of Gledhow Hall, Leeds; 2° ∞ 2° 1916 Mary Louisa Milnes Wright [∞ 1° Rev. R. K. Snowdon]
⇒ John Rhodes (1877–1902sa), lieutenant, Royal Scotch Greys, died Transvaal
⇒ Gerald, Alice, Dorothy
⇒ Mary (–1915) ∞ 1874 Sir Edward Carbutt (1838–1905spms)
