⇒ Thomas, 2<sup>nd</sup> Baron Grantham (1738–1786), ambassador to Madrid 1771–79 {*Reynolds; Romney*} ∞ 1780 Lady Mary Jemima Yorke (1757–1830) {*Reynolds; Romney*} *q.v.*

⇒ Thomas Philip Robinson Weddell de Grey, 3<sup>rd</sup> Baron Grantham, 2<sup>nd</sup> Earl de Grey, 6<sup>th</sup> Lord Lucas (1781–1859<sup>spm</sup>) {*Gardner; Reynolds*}

⇒ Anne, 7th Baroness Lucas *s.j.* ∞ 6th Earl Cowper

⇒ Frederick John Robinson, 1<sup>st</sup> Earl of Rippon (1782–1859), prime minister {*Gardner; Reynolds*}

⇒ Philip Robinson (1783–1794) {*Gardner; Reynolds*}

⇒ Theresa ?Frances Robinson (1745–1775) {*Kauffmann; Hamilton; Reynolds*} ∞ 1769 John Parker, 1<sup>st</sup> Baron Boringdon 1784 (1734–1788), of Saltram House {*Hamilton; Reynolds*}

⇒ John Parker, 1<sup>st</sup> Earl of Morley (1772–1840) {*Downman; Gardner; Noldekens; Northcote; Reynolds*} ∞ 1<sup>o</sup> 1804 Lady Augusta Fane; 2<sup>o</sup> 1809 Frances Talbot

⇒ Theresa (1775–1856) {*Reynolds*} ∞ 1798 Hon. George Villiers

⇒ Frederick “Fritz” Robinson (1746–1792<sup>sp</sup>), secretary to Grantham in Madrid 1771–78 {*Romney*} ∞ 1785 Katherine Gertrude Harris (1750–1834) {*Romney*}, sister of 1<sup>st</sup> Earl of Malmesbury *q.v.*

⇒ Anne “Nanny” Robinson (–p.1775), lived at Saltram following Theresa’s death
