⇒⇒⇒ Major-General Sir Frederick William Trench (1777–1859), KCH, MP, adc to George IV

⇒⇒⇒ Sarah Helena Trench (1793–1859) {*Comerford*} 2<sup>o</sup> ∞ 1815 Sir Compton Pocklington Tempesque Domville, 1<sup>st</sup> Bt (1778–1857) {*Hamilton*} [son of Charles Domville, né Peoklington (c.1739–1810), MP {*Hamilton*} ∞ 1774 Margaret Sheppard] ∞ 1<sup>o</sup> 1811 Elizabeth Frances Lindsay
