Sir John Temple, ?8th Bt of Stowe (1732–1798), commissioner for customs, British consul to USA 1785–98 {*Copley; Sharples; Trumbull*} ∞ 1767 Elizabeth Bowdoin (1750–1809) {*Copley; Sharples*}, dau. of Gov. James Bowdoin & Elizabeth Erving

⇒ Elizabeth ∞ 1786 Thomas Lindall Winthrop (1760–1841), merchant in Boston

⇒⇒ Robert Charles Winthrop; ⇒⇒ Clara Bowdoin Winthrop

Sir John Temple, Bt (1600–1677), master of the rolls in Ireland

⇒ Sir William Temple (1628–1699), diplomat and author, delegate to the Nijmegen conference {*C. Beale; Lely; Netscher; Tuer?; B Vaillant*} ∞ Dorothy Osborne {*Lely; Netscher*}

⇒ Sir John Temple (–1704), attorney general in Ireland

⇒⇒ Henry Temple, 1st Viscount Palmerston (c.1673–1757) ∞ 1^o 1703 Anne Houblon (1682–1735), dau. of Abraham Houblon

⇒⇒⇒ Henry Temple (–1740dvp) ∞ 1^o 1735 Elizabeth Lee (–1736); 2^o 1738 Jane Bernard (–1789), dau. of Sir John Bernard, Bt, Lord Mayor of London & Jane Godschall, aunt of Sarah Godschall, Mrs William Man

⇒⇒⇒⇒ Henry John Temple, 2nd Viscount Palmerston (1739–1802) ∞ 1^o 1767 Frances Poole (–1769dsps) {*Gardner; Hamilton*}; 2^o 1783 Mary Mee (–1805), dau. of Benjamin Mee of Bath

⇒⇒⇒⇒⇒ Henry John Temple, 3rd Viscount Palmerston (1784–1865sp), prime minister ∞ 1839 Emily Mary Lamb (1787–1869), sister of Lord Melbourne
