Edward Tucker (–1737), MP for Weymouth 1727–37 ∞ 1701 Rebecca Gollop

⇒ John Tucker (1701–1779sp), paymaster of marines 1757–78, MP for Weymouth 1735–47, 1754–78, mayor of Weymouth, member of the Hell-Fire Club { *Hudson; J.-F. de Troy* } ∞ 1731 Martha Gollop, dau. of George Gollop of Berwick, Dorset, sister of Mary Gollop

⇒ Richard Tucker (1704–1777), surveyor of HM's quarries in Portland { *Hayman; Robinson* } ∞ 1734 Sarah Gollop (1703–1779) { *Hayman* }, sister of Martha G.

⇒⇒ Rebecca Tucker (1738–p.1779) { *Cotes* } ∞ 1765 Gabriel Steward (1731–1792), of Nottingham, Melcombe Regis, captain, East India service, MP for Weymouth 1778–88, paymaster of marines 1779–92 [brother of Francis Steward (1743–1798), mayor of Weymouth { *Beach* } ∞ 1768 Martha Seymer (–p.1798) { *Cotes* }]

⇒⇒⇒ Gabriel Tucker Steward (1769–1836), MP 1794–1810

⇒⇒⇒ Richard Augustus Tucker Steward (1773–1842), captain, dorset militia 1798, MP ∞ 1823 Louisa Henrietta Morgan

⇒⇒⇒ Edward Tucker Steward (1774–?1847), [prector of Wem, Shropshire]

⇒⇒⇒ Sarah Dorothea ∞ 1795 Robert Browne of Morton House ⇒ desc.
