⇒⇒⇒⇒ Charles Watson-Wentworth, 2nd Marquess of Rockingham (1730–1782sp), KG 1760, FRS, prime minister {*Cotes; Nollekens; ?Pond; Reynolds; Romney; Seaman; Tassie; D Wilson; English sch.*} ∞ 1752 Mary Bright (1735–1804) {*Hamilton*}, dau. of Thomas Bright, né Liddell of Badsworth & Margaret Norton, later Lady Ramsden {*Hamilton*} [∞ 1^o], mother of Mary, Marchioness of Rockingham (1735–1804)
