BERTHÉLEMY, Jean-Simon

Laon 5.III.1743 – Paris 1.III.1811

History painter and very occasional portraitist. The son of a sculptor, he was a pupil of Noël Hallé at the École de l'Académie royale from 1763; grand prix 1767; agrégé 1777; reçu 1781.
