TRENGOVE, Thomas Prynn

Perranarworthal, Cornwall, bpt 30.VII.1747–
p.1773

“From the Royal Academy, London”,
advertised in the *Sherborne Mercury*, 19.VII.1773,
his intention of settling in Truro to paint
portraits, landscapes and miniatures in various
media including crayons. He had been admitted
to the RA schools on 18.XII.1771, aged “24 next
July” [an error for last July; Hutchison 1960 also
misspells the name Trengrove]. He is unlikely to
be the illiterate Thomas Trengove who married
Catharine Gall in his home village on 29.X.1786.
