⇒⇒⇒ Barry Maxwell, Baron, Viscount 1781, Earl 1785 Farnham (p.1721–1800) {*Hamilton*} ∞ 1<sup>o</sup> 1751/57 Margaret King (–1766); 2<sup>o</sup> Grace Burdett (1734–1816) {*Hamilton*}

⇒⇒⇒ John James Maxwell, Earl of Farnham (1759–1823sp) ∞ 1784 Grace Cuffe (1766–1856), dau. of Thomas Cuffe & Thomasina Herbert
